SVI AREA GUIDE HOUSE LEGACY COMMITTEE UPDATE

The Committee is happy to report that several proposals have been approved by Area Council and we will hopefully be able to implement some of them as soon as this camping season! This is GREAT news! Here is what has been approved and what projects are beginning:

- A major project at Milnes Lower Cabin will upgrade the accessibility and entryway to the washroom from the cabin doors. This will include a roof extension and paving.
- Installation of a Reflection Zone by Bay-to-Bay Rangers hopefully this summer.
- Canoe fund for Kingswood Camp three used Clipper Canoes and some new PFDs have been purchased.
- Purchase of Stand-Up Paddleboards (SUP), PFD's and an inflator.
- Tent platforms to be installed at Kingswood Camp.
- Bunkies (small cabins) may be installed at Jubilee in the future. Improvements to
 the two Pan abodes will be considered to see if doors can be installed that would
 allow them to be used as sleeping accommodation.



All camps are receiving improvements, but we need assistance from the membership.

This committee is facilitating the ideas and proposal process, but it is not in the mandate of the Legacy

Committee to necessarily put the projects into action. No amount of involvement is too small, be it help with planning, labour, professional expertise, or any other contribution.
