The New Guider Learning Path is a series of 5 courses that ensures Guiders feel confident and prepared to lead their units. The BC Training Committee will be offering 2 of these courses in April - Building Unit Guiders Skills and All About the Branch both with a focus on Sparks & Brownies! Guiders are encouraged to take the ecourse version of 'The Girl Program' before attending any of the sessions as points within that course may be talked about during these trainings.

All Guiders are required to complete the 5 courses of the New Guider Learning path within their first six months of joining Girl Guides of Canada. Attending these sessions and taking the recommended ecourse, would complete 3 out of the five requirements.
